PROGRAM IMPACT UPDATE

NAVY SEAL FOUNDATION SURVIVOR SUPPORT PROGRAM

The Foundation provides a range of programs and services to those warriors and families who have sustained injuries, illnesses or catastrophic loss during, or because of, their Naval Special Warfare (NSW) service.

When an NSW service member is injured or becomes critically ill, the Navy SEAL Foundation provides financial and logistical support so the service member's focus can be on healing. Additionally, we provide support for the warrior who suffers the loss of a parent or sibling.

For those who have made the ultimate sacrifice, we stand firmly behind their family during this time of crisis. Immediate financial assistance is provided to the surviving family to help cover costs associated with the dignified transfer of remains and memorial services, as well as travel expenses for the immediate and extended family.

Surviving families are provided a variety of vital services to children, spouses, and parents of fallen warriors in their time of need and into the future. NSF provides mortgage and rent assistance, home maintenance programs, financial and grief counseling, legal assistance, respite childcare, and other critical services. Our support continues for these families in the years following their loss through our specialized camps, retreats, and bereavement activities.



Every year in April, NSF sends surviving spouses and caregivers of surviving children our annual

Home Care Stipend. This Survivor Support program was created in 2015 to help offset costs associated with the general upkeep of a home. Our Home Care Stipend empowers surviving spouses and caregivers to address home care and maintenance issues with confidence while providing peace of mind.


