We are pleased to announce the recent hiring of retired SEAL [Chris Irwin](#) to the position of Director of Development for the West Coast Region.



Chris is a Distinguished Graduate of the United States Naval Academy and earned his Master of Philosophy in International Relations from the University of Cambridge. In 1999, Chris graduated from BUD/S Class 221 with orders to SEAL Team FIVE. Over the next 12 years, he served at Naval Special Warfare Development Group, Naval Special Warfare Unit TWO, and Naval Special Warfare Unit TEN leaving active duty in 2011. Chris then served an additional six years in the Naval Reserve, retiring in 2017 with 20 years of federal service.

Following his military service, Chris became an entrepreneur with a focus on giving back to his SEAL brotherhood and local communities. He and his family moved to St. Thomas where they founded the first CrossFit gym in the Virgin Islands, building a passionate community of over 150 members. In 2013, Chris became the President of Kill Cliff Inc, a SEAL-Founded, healthy sports drink company. While there, he established the company's "Official Partnership" with the Navy SEAL Foundation—the first of its kind. To date, Kill Cliff has raised and donated over \$600,000 in cash, event sponsorships and product equivalencies in support of the mission of the Foundation.

"I just wanted to reiterate how much we appreciate the efforts of the NSF, along with all the fantastic counselors that spent their time with our (NSW) kids this week!

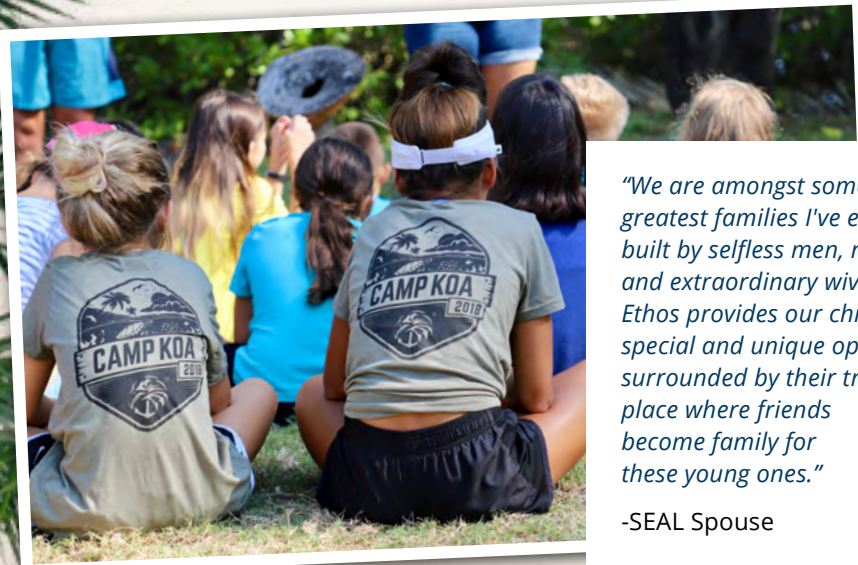

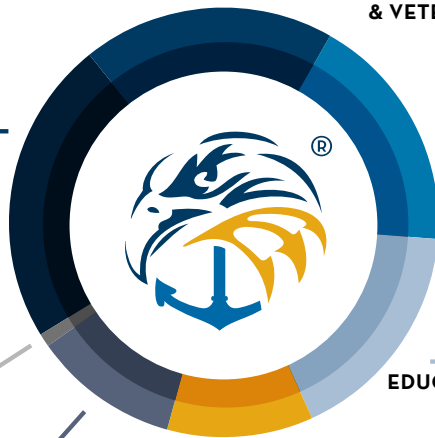
